## **Carson-Newman College Begins Master of Arts in Applied Theology**

Beginning August 6, Carson-Newman is offering the M.A.A.T. to address the practical need for advanced theological training in East Tennessee. The 36 hour program targets three specific groups: professionals in the market place with no formal theological education who seek to explore the practical yet sophisticated application of faith and doctrine to church, individual and non-religious vocational life; recent religion graduates; and experienced clergy and ministerial personnel. Most classes are offered on Friday evenings and Saturdays. Cost is \$375 per credit hour, with an additional cost for the international trips. The program is directed by Dr. David Crutchley, who has led our January Bible Study the past three years and is Chair of the Religion Department at C-N. *(There is also an opportunity to blend this M.A.A.T. with either an M.B.A. or M.S. in Counseling.)*

### **GriefShare**

GriefShare is an ongoing support program for anyone who has gone through the death of someone close to them. GriefShare is a weekly video seminar featuring some of the nation's foremost experts on grief recovery topics. Each seminar is combined with a grief support group discussion time to allow group participants to talk about the content of the seminar and about how they are dealing with the death of their loved one. The program is designed to bring insight into the process of grief and to bring together people able to encourage and support each other in this difficult time of life. The combination of instruction and small group sharing can bring the peace of God to troubled hearts. It assists in the journey from grieving to joy.

You are welcome to begin attending the GriefShare group at any session. Each is "self-contained," so you do not have to attend in sequence. You will find encouragement and help whenever you begin. You will be able to continue with GriefShare through the next cycle and view any of the videos you have not seen.

#### **Bus to UT Football Games**

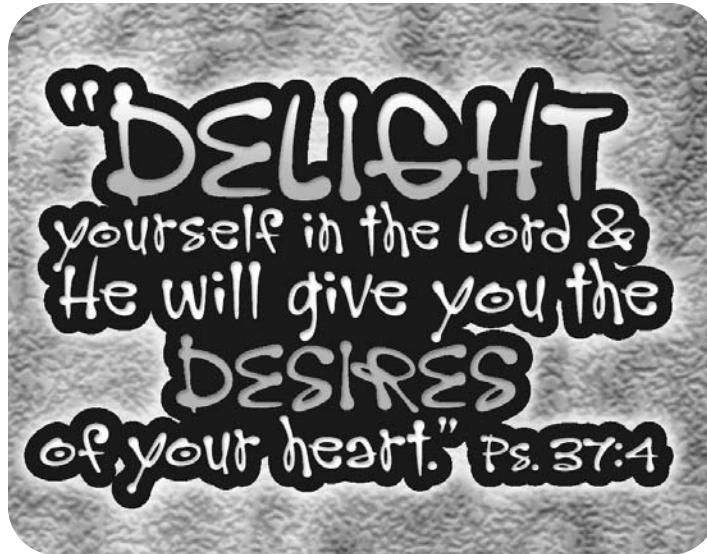
Effective 2010 season, we will no longer run the bus to UT football games. Thanks to Paul Casteel for his years of dedication to this ministry.
